KEY POINT

KEY VERSE

SHARE

DO

Cut out a star shape. On each tip of the star write something to pray for. Use this star each night for bedtime prayers.

PRAY

Go outside or look out the window and count how many stars you can see. For each star counted, name one person you are grateful for and why.

BLESS

Trace a star on the hands of one another, and say, "May God's love shine within you for all the world to see. Amen."
